Important Transportation Information:

HVACR and Heating competitors are on a different transportation schedule than all other competitors. Because of the time crunch, the following transportation/contest schedule will be followed and strictly adhered to on Saturday, April 8, 2017!

- All HVACR and Heating competitors will need to be at the Amway Grand Plaza Hotel on the Lyon Street side of the hotel by 6:30 am for transportation to FSU. The bus will arrive and depart from the Amway Grand Plaza Hotel on the Lyon Street side of the hotel. Lyon Street is on the back side of the hotel between the Amway and DeVos Place.
- The bus to FSU will leave from the Amway Grand Plaza Hotel at exactly 6:45 am. Any competitor not on the bus at that time will need to find their own transportation to FSU.
- Only competitors will be bused to the contest site.
- All contests will start precisely at 8:00 am. Any competitor not at FSU by 8:00 am will be disqualified.

RESUME:

Each student must submit a one-page printed resume before the contest start at the contest site (present to contest coordinator, not judges). The resume is no longer submitted online. This is the only time that resumes can be turned in. Failure to do so will result in a 10 point penalty.

TASKS TO BE PERFORMED:

- Written examination to include technical and/or SkillsUSA knowledge.
- Forming, soldering, flaring with oxy-acetylene or turbo torch.
- Control and component identification.
- Compressor analysis and identification.
- Drawing of diagrams and schematics (across the lines) of commercial, domestic or air-conditioning units.
- Refrigerant recovery.
- Service troubleshooting (diagnosis of electrical and/or mechanical)

- Air flow measurements
- Window air conditioners
- Self-contained air conditioners
- Roof-top air conditioners, heating units
- Commercial refrigeration units, walk-ins and display cases, air or water cooled
- Split air conditioners
- Gas and/or oil furnaces
- Ice machines

STUDENTS MUST SUPPLY:

- Manifold gauges R410 Compatible
- Safety glasses with side shields or goggles
- Work shoes (No Athletic Type)
- Volt-amp meter
- Ohmmeter
- Refrigeration wrench
- Temperature tester or dial thermometer
- #2 pencil
- No jumper wires
- Calculator
- Resume – 1 page
