



Statesman Award Instructions

1. This award can be earned by any SkillsUSA Michigan member and is available only at the State Conference.
2. You will have from 8:00 pm to 10:00 pm on Saturday only to complete your Statesman Award checklist.
 - a. No checklists will be accepted before or after the indicated times.
3. You should already have a checklist, including the answers.
 - b. If you don't have a checklist, there are extras by the front door.
4. Your task is to recite the answer to each question to a State Officer.
 - c. If it is correct, then that State Officer will initial your checklist.
 - d. If not, then go back, study and try again.
5. There are State Officers and Alumni Members around the room.
 - e. Each State Officer or Alumni Member can only sign your checklist a maximum of three times.
 - i. For Example: Our Historian can initial your checklist three times.
6. Once you have everything checked off, please turn in your checklist to the front stage.
 - f. One State Officer and one Alumni member will be at the front stage to review your checklist for completion.
 - g. If your checklist is verified as complete, you will receive your Statesman Pin. A certificate will be mailed to your school after the State Conference.
 - h. If it is not completed, you will be asked to go back and complete it.
7. Reminder: you only have until 10:00 pm on Saturday to complete your checklist.
