- 4. Identify security issues including but not limited to user accounts, group policy editing, encryption, virus activity, registry problems and browser security.
- 5. Demonstrate ability to manipulate a pc and create automation using the command line.
- 6. Demonstrate the ability to identify, install, and configure wired/wireless connections.
- 7. Identify ports/parts of a PC
- 8. Demonstrate use of cable tester and other computing tools
- 9. Patch cable building
