- Clothing must be appropriate for the interview portion of the contest.
- No logos, no names, all identifying information must be covered
- 2021 only – no deductions will be made if official dress is not available

STUDENTS MUST SUPPLY:

- Resume – 1 page to be uploaded
- Calculator
- Most current version of the National Electrical Code.

PURPOSE

The Electrical Construction Wiring event will allow each contestant the opportunity to perform in a practical work environment. Each contestant will have the opportunity to use his or her acquired electrical wiring skills and employability skills to complete an assessment, job interview, online application and upload a resume'.

SCOPE OF THE CONTEST

The contest will assess the ability to perform jobs or skills selected from the following list of competencies as determined by the SkillsUSA Championships technical committee.

CONTEST REQUIREMENTS:

Contestant scores from each part of the contest will be used to evaluate contestants overall score. The highest overall score (minus any penalty points) will be chosen as the national qualifying contestant.

1) TECHNICAL ASSESSMENT

Student will complete the technical written assessment on the Conference LMS.

- Contestants will complete the assessment from 9:00 am to 10:00 am, April 17th.
- Technical assessments are created to reflect national technical assessments.
- There are no study guides.
- 50 questions
- 60 minutes

- Refer to the national technical standards for information regarding this contests required skills and competencies.
- 2) ONLINE APPLICATION:
 - The contestant will complete an online application
 - 3) Resume':
 - Contestant will upload their one-page typed resume to the judge.
 - 4) TECHNICAL INTERVIEW
 - Interview: 10-15 minutes will be dedicated to the judge interviewing the contestant with several interview questions meant to evaluate student's skills related to the career field.

Scoring Range	Excellent interview: You should get a job offer! Great demonstration of technical skills.	Average interview: You could get called back, but it is not certain.
