



State-Wide Food Sculpture Contest

SkillsUSA Michigan invites everyone to participate in the State-Wide Food Sculpture Contest! Collect non-perishable food items and/or paper products at your school and create a sculpture out of what you collect!

Each sculpture will be made of non-perishable food items and/or household paper products collected by your school. All items in the sculpture must be in their original containers and not opened. The sculpture items will then be donated to a charity of your choosing.

At the State Conference, SkillsUSA Michigan State Officers will recognize one school in each of the following categories:

- Most Creative Sculpture
- Most Items in Sculpture
- Sculpture Best Portraying SkillsUSA

A tip from Dave Urlaub from Bay Arenac ISD Career Center is to use several of your chapter's career cluster programs when planning your sculpture: *"I use my Engineering / Drafting program to help with the design, the Graphics and Printing program to help with any graphics, and the Building Trades program for the support system."*

Guidelines:

- One entry per school.
- Each school can only win in one category.
- You may utilize structural supports in your sculpture.
- Each entry will consist of a picture(s) of your sculpture and a receipt from the charity of your choice for your donated items.
- Both the picture(s) and the receipt from a charity must be submitted to qualify.
- The picture(s) should be at least 4" x 6" and must show the entire sculpture.
- **NEW DEADLINE AND SUBMISSION PROCEDURE:** All picture(s) and receipts must be submitted by April 1, 2023, via email to aday7@emich.edu Please limit your submission to one email. Multiple attachments in the one email are acceptable.
- The receipt must contain the following information:
 - o Name of Charity
 - o Date
 - o School Name
 - o Total Number of Items Donated
 - o Signature of Person Receiving the Donation

Please note that food items will NOT be accepted at the State Conference.
