TASKS TO BE PERFORMED:

- FRIDAY'S PRESENTATION TEAM TIMES WILL BE POSTED: 12:30 PM-5:00 PM
- TEAMS MAY DROP THEIR TOOLS OFF AT THE DEVOS PLACE ON FRIDAY 1PM - 5PM. OR AM SAT.
Attend the Networking session in DeVos with copies of resumes Friday night.
- SAT. TEAM WILL CHECK IN AT 8:00 AM- CONTEST WILL END AT 3:00 PM
- CLEAN UP AND TEAR DOWN 2-3 PM (ALL TEAMS WILL PARTICIPATE AND SCORED)

OVERALL TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES:

- ALL WORK WILL BE PERFORMED IN A QUALITY, PROFESSIONAL, AND WORKMANSHIP LIKE MANNER.
- COOPERATION AMONG ALL PHASES OF CONSTRUCTION IS NECESSARY.
- KEEP WORK AREA CLEAN AND FREE FROM HAZARDS.
- BECOME FAMILIAR WITH AND MAINTAIN SAFETY STANDARDS AT ALL TIMES.
- SAFETY PENALTIES WILL BE ASSESSED WITH GRADUATED TIME PENALTIES AS INFRACTIONS OCCUR. 3 INFRACTIONS SHALL CONSTITUTE DISQUALIFICATION. FIRST VIOLATION IS AN INDIVIDUAL 10 MINUTE TIMEOUT. SECOND VIOLATION IS A 15 MINUTE TEAM TIMEOUT. A THIRD VIOLATION IS A THIRTY MINUTE TEAM TIMEOUT OR DISQUALIFICATION AT THE LEAD JUDGES DISCRETION.
- WEAR SAFETY GLASSES WITH SIDE SHIELDS OR GOGGLES, AND APPROPRIATE WORK SHOES OR BOOTS.
- ALL CONTESTANTS MUST REMAIN AT THE CONTEST SITE UNTIL JUDGING AND CLEAN UP IS COMPLETED. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.
- TEAMS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN LUNCHES AND DRINKS.
- A GROUP TEAM AREA WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR LUNCHES.

- CARPENTER, ELECTRICIAN, MASON, PLUMBER.

- TURN IN INDIVIDUAL COPIES OF OSHA CARD AT PRESENTATION ON FRIDAY

SCOPE OF WORK:

- FRAME WOOD STRUCTURE, RAFTERS, STAIRS
- WIRE INTERIOR, AND EXTERIOR
- EXTERIOR BRICK AND BLOCK
- ROUGH PLUMBING for sink, washer machine, exterior hose and vent pipe through roof
- PRESENTATION OF WORK PLAN

Carpentry:

Frame wood walls and sheet, 2x4, 2x6 and rough frame window opening. Layout, cut and install common rafters.

Electrical:

Wire a service panel. Wire both fifteen- and twenty-amp circuits. Wire single pole switches and 3-way switches, GFCI weatherproof and convenience outlets, and lighting switch loops.

Plumbing:

Use PVC for DWV plumb lines. Use copper and PEX for freshwater supplies. Supply your own ½” and ¾” crimp rings and crimping tool. Install frost proof sillcock.

Masonry:

Install outside corner brick veneer at prescribed coursing. No story pole or dead heads will be allowed.
